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INTRODUCTION

"The racial mix of the dentist workforce does not reflect the U.S. population. Black and Hispanic dentists are significantly underrepresented..." - ADA HPI

The 2022 ADA HPI data highlights a stark reality in the dental profession, with only 3.8% Black, 5.9% Hispanic, and 0.3% Alaskan Indian/Native American dentists among the total of 202,536. This glaring lack of diversity has significant repercussions for our community's wellbeing and health.

The importance of a diverse dental workforce cannot be overstated. **A dental population that mirrors the diversity of the communities it serves holds the key to improving oral health outcomes.** Cultural competency, enhanced patient care, and a reduction in biases are critical components that arise from a diverse representation in dentistry. By addressing this disparity, we not only create a more inclusive profession but also pave the way for better oral health for all.



Diversity In Dentistry Mentorships, Inc. (DIDM) aims to improve the pathway for historically underrepresented students from middle to dental school through mentorship, education, hands-on experiences, and awards tailored for youth and pre-dental students. We do this through two signature programs: Diversify Dentistry Youth Summits[™] identifies and empowers students to explore the oral health profession. Our Virtual Mentorship program for pre-dental students offers personalized guidance and resources to help them become competitive dental school applicants. We distinguish ourselves by providing one-on-one mentorship to support this goal.



THE CHALLENGES

The challenges we currently face in dentistry are:

- 1. The number of Black dentists in the U.S. has not changed in 15 years.
- 2. The representation of African American/Black, Hispanic/Latinx, American Indian, Alaskan Native and Pacific Islander dentists is disproportionate to the U.S. population.





- 3. Population parity between dentists and served communities are critical to provide competent and accessible care to historically underrepresented groups (HUGs). Lack of cultural competence leads to ineffective communication, bias, and ultimately results in inequity in the delivery of oral healthcare.
- 4. From 2005 to 2020, the number of enrolled first year dental students for Hispanics improved from 6.1% to 10.8% but for Black students, it decreased from 6.7% to 6.2%.



THE SOLUTIONS

We connect students with dental mentors who share their values and believe in their potential.

By providing engaging curriculum and having fun along the way, we will inspire and prepare the next generation of diverse dentists! We aim to achieve this through Exploration, Education, and Empowerment.




TEEN PROGRAM

Our Diversify Dentistry Youth Summit is a call-toaction for dentists, educators, and corporate leaders who recognize the need to connect historically underrepresented youths to the dental profession to create opportunity and plant the seed of possibility within them.

Since our inaugural **DIVERSIFY DENTISTRY YOUTH SUMMIT** hosted at SPEAR in 2021, we've inspired underrepresented middle and high school students to consider a career in dentistry. For 2023, we held two youth summits, which welcomed sixty-one youths and two Pre-Dental Mentees from historically underrepresented groups to inspire the next generation of dental applicant pool, aiming to redefine the future of dentistry. In fact, our Mentee of the Year, Ashley Lynn, was inspired to apply to ATSU, a dental school that was not previously on her radar. We are on track to host 4 Summits in 2024 and double it in 2025!

The pursuit of an inclusive dental landscape depends on nurturing the potential of young minds. These transformative summits



served as a guiding beacon, igniting a dream in underrepresented youths. Students partnered with dentist mentors and experienced immersive dental anatomy, hands-on laboratory experiences, and engaging discussions. The pinnacle of this inspirational day was marked by a "white coat" ceremony, symbolizing the timeless passage into the rewarding realm of dentistry.
